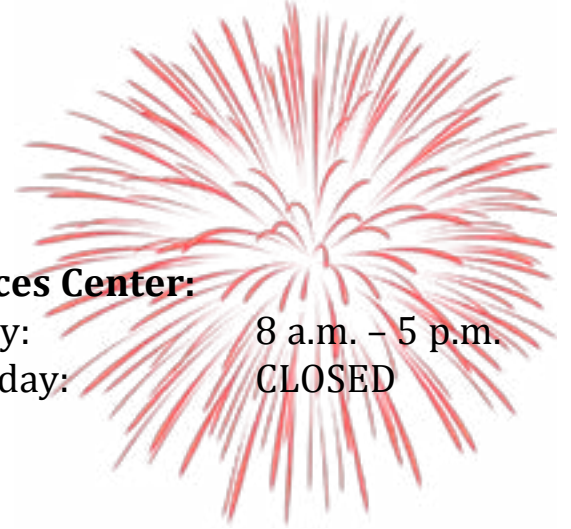

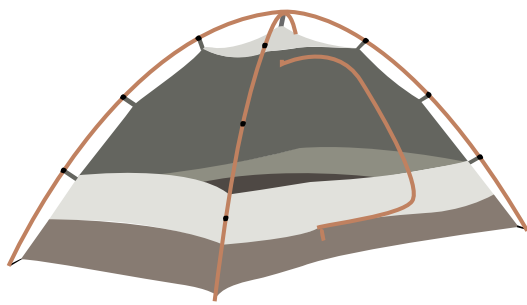

SRC Projects – Summer 2017



The City of Carbondale Bike-Way continues to be constructed on campus. Crews started by the Towers and have moved northward, expanding the current size of the sidewalk and creating a new pathway that splits the SRC and the Newman Center property.

Work is being finalized on the new “central Fitness Studio” in the area where the old Martial Arts room was. This room will offer an array of selectorized equipment, some cardio options, stretching areas, a plyo area, and dumbbell area. The martial Arts Room moved upstairs into Room 158 and several pieces were relocated to the mat Room on the west side of the facility as well as the Boxing Room.

Work on member Services will commence soon. Member services is moving downstairs and will be staffed many times when the SRC is open. Expect a July transition for this area.

A new canoe/boat rack system is being constructed in the Base Camp area behind the SRC to accommodate boats coming to us from Campus lake. This project will commence in early July and will permit much more storage of boats and canoes for the department.
